# Term Selection Points to Consider General Term Selection Principles Quality of Source Data Term Selection points Versioning



### **Term Selection Points - Examples**

- Diagnoses and Provisional Diagnoses with or without Signs and Symptoms
- Death and Other Patient Outcomes
- Suicide and Self-Harm
- Combination Terms
- Exposures During Pregnancy and Breast Feeding
- Congenital Terms
- Neoplasms
- Medical and Surgical Procedures
- Investigations
- Off Label Use
- Misuse, Abuse and Addiction



## **Example from Term Selection PtC**

### 3.5.4 When to "split" into more than one MedDRA term

If "splitting" the reported ARs/AEs provides more clinical information, select more than one MedDRA term.

Example

Reported	LLT Selected
Diarrhea and vomiting	Diarrhea Vomiting
Wrist fracture due to fall	Wrist fracture Fall



# **Points of Note**

 In some cases with more than one option for selecting terms, a "preferred option" is identified but this does not limit MedDRA users to applying that option. Organizations should be consistent in their choice of option.
